Since 1978, the Goh Ballet, under direction by Chan Hon Goh since 2010, has been on the forefront of artistic expression, cultivating a crew of some of the best dancers that the world has to offer.

This year, the Nutcracker ballet welcomes Paloma Herrera as principal dancer with the American Ballet Theatre, who will perform as the renowned Sugar Plum Fairy, and Dmitri Dovgoselets of the Royal Winnipeg Ballet. There's also an amazing cast of more than 200 dancers who will captivate and twirl on the stage. Each dancer was carefully chosen from a wide range of actors, with children as young as six years old part of the show!

If design is more your thing, then the Goh Ballet seeks to impress. Their costumes have been created by award-winning designers and the sets are multi-layered and hand-painted, allowing rich, beautiful colours and some of their magical props will surprise even the most stoic of theatre-goers! There's even a live magic show as part of the performance!

The Goh Ballet's Nutcracker runs from December 18-22nd at The Centre on Homer Street, so don't miss your chance to be part of this holiday tradition!
